These are the answers.

- Getting the harvest in was hard work because the implements had been designed for humans and the animals couldn't use any tool which involved standing on his back legs.
- 2. The pigs did not actually work. They directed and supervised the others.
- 3. Boxer is the 'admiration of everybody' because he is so strong. 'He seemed more like three horses than one.'
- 4. Benjamin the donkey seems unchanged since the rebellion.
- 5. When Benjamin is asked whether he is not happier now that Jones has gone, he says 'none of you has ever seen a dead donkey'.
- 6. Snowball's committees include:
 - the Egg Production Committee
 - the Clean Tails League
 - the Wild Comrades' Re-education Committee
 - the Whiter Wool Movement for the sheep
 - classes in reading and writing
- 7. Snowball reduces the Seven Commandments to a single maxim: 'four legs good, two legs bad'
- 8. Jessie and Bluebell give birth to puppies. After they have been weaned, Napoleon takes them away from their mothers and says he will take over their education.
- 9. At the end of the chapter, the mystery of where the milk went is cleared up. It had gone to the pigs and was mixed into their mash.
- 10. Squealer explains the decision about the milk and apples. He warns that if the pigs are not given these items, Jones could come back.
